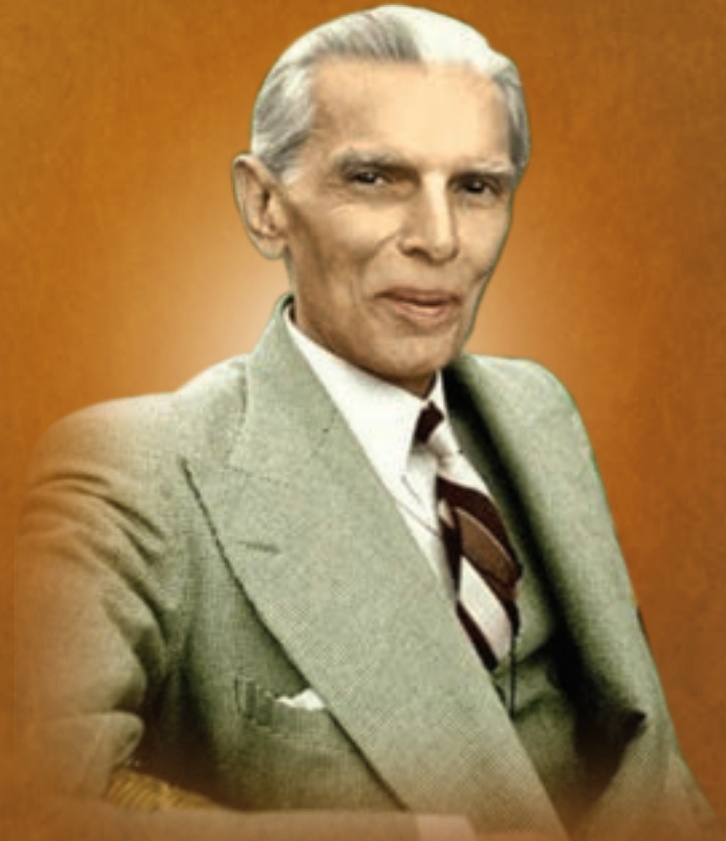

INTRODUCTION OF INDUS MEDICAL COLLEGE

The campus of the college is purpose-built in an eight-storied ultra-modern building with the latest facilities. The learning resource center consists of a Library and fully air-conditioned two computer labs with two hundred latest computer workstations to cater to the research and educational needs of the students and the faculty. The college has fully equipped laboratories and museums with advanced instruments and models for the pragmatic teaching of medical students. INFRASTRUCTURE

The campus is situated on 5 Acres of land with a covered area of more than 150,000 sq ft., in the heart of the educational hub of Tando Muhammad Khan with very easy access on the main Hyderabad – Badin road Tando Muhammad Khan, having state of the art infrastructure, which include academic blocks, sports grounds, library, cafeteria, girls' hostel, mosque, labs & Indus Medical College Hospital.



AUDITORIUM

The campus has a fully furnished, centrally air conditioned auditorium with a seating capacity of more than 300 Persons for conducting various events like seminars, conferences, and lectures, etc. The auditorium is well equipped with the latest Audio/Visual system.

LIBRARY

Libraries serve the community with up-to-date information through different sources. The campus has a digital library, online research journals, periodicals. All users from faculty, staff, or students are encouraged to make full use of available resources. It contains around 1700 books on medical and allied health sciences subjects. Internet facilities in the library connect users & provide access to books, journals, theses, newspapers, and other resources in a hybrid environment (i.e., a combination of print and online resources). IMC library has access to the Higher Education Commission (HEC) Digital Library that provides thousands of virtual reference sources, online books, electronic journals, digital theses, and other multimedia resources on various subjects. The library is equipped with the latest technology like Library Management System and is providing users the facility of borrowing and returning library material.

Comfortable interior and innovative furniture in the libraries make them stunning and provide a refreshing environment that attracts users and compels them to spend time and study in a relaxed and conducive environment. Study carrels and study lounge for faculty and students provide an excellent atmosphere.



IT FACILITIES

The information & Communication Technology (ICT) department is responsible for ensuring the adequacy of academic and administrative computing facilities at IMC. DEPARTMENT OF ANATOMY

Anatomy is the branch of science which deals with the structural organization of the living things. The department of anatomy is located on the ground floor of IMC building. The department is fully air conditioned and all the labs are well equipped with latest Audio-Visual aids to facilitate the students. The department has a "State of the art" museum which is fully equipped with a large number of gross anatomical as well as embryological models. The dissection hall is also fully air-conditioned and has a large mortuary. Histology lab is also equipped with latest slide projection microscope and LEDs for small group discussions and latest binocular microscopes for self-study by the students.

The department has very enthusiastic and experienced teaching faculty which is known for its student friendly methods of teaching.



DEPARTMENT OF BIOCHEMISTRY

The Department of Biochemistry aims to provide high-quality education to students studying MBBS and a variety of other Allied Health Sciences. The aim is to educate medical and allied health professionals with better understanding of Biochemistry and to provide scientific manpower that can better serve the community. The novel research in this area will add the foundation of knowledge and improve the quality of life. Students in this department will be a source of pride for the college by making significant contributions to national growth. The course of Biochemistry aims to give the students an understanding of the structure, function and working of human body at cellular, sub cellular and molecular level, both in health as well as disease. Laboratory practical classes are held to assist in elucidating the concepts discussed in lectures and seminars. Students are introduced to methods of biochemical investigations, relevant to clinical sciences. They are also introduced to the concepts of clinical biochemistry, in which measurement of bio-molecules is used for diagnosis and monitoring of the diseased states. Modern techniques used in the clinical service and basic research laboratories are introduced with hands on various procedures to familiarize the students with scientific basis of modern methods along with their limitations and facilities.

DEPARTMENT OF PHYSIOLOGY

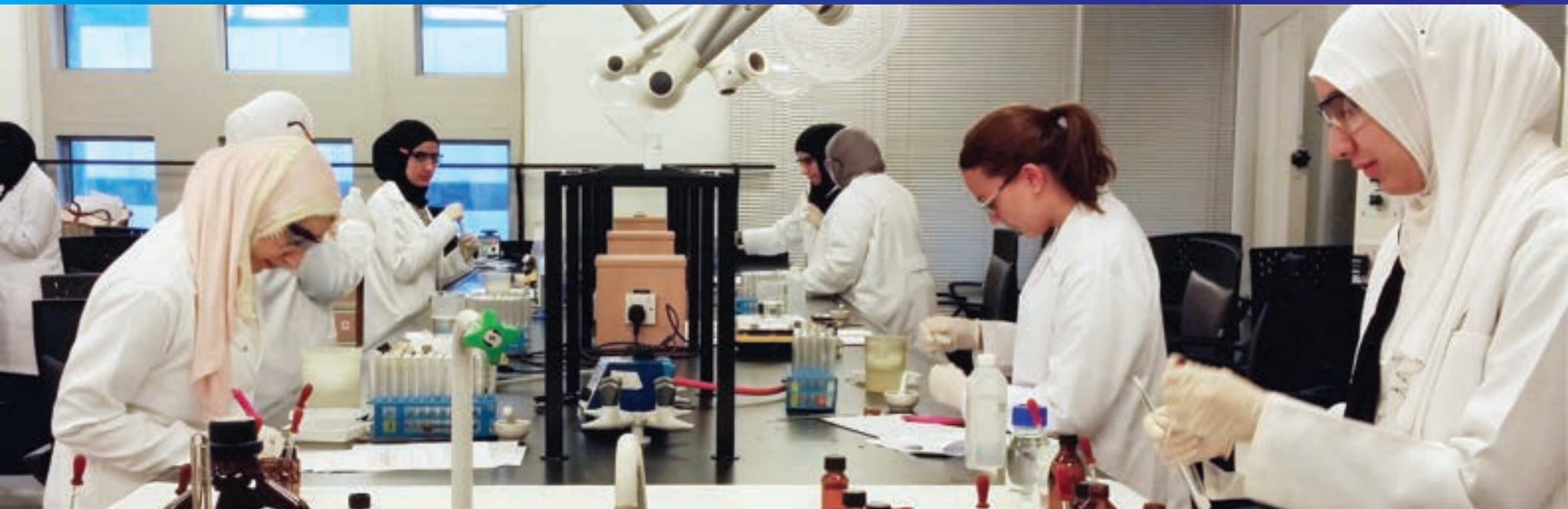
The mission of the Physiology department is to educate, train and inspire young people in the science of healing by imparting systematic, factual, and current knowledge of normal body processes using modern techniques and information along with proven conventional approaches of teaching in the subject of Physiology.

The department of Physiology at Indus Medical College is responsible for teaching the subject of Physiology to MBBS Classes and Allied Health Sciences classes. Faculty have designed strategies in the curriculum for the early introduction of MBBS students to Research Methodology encompassing applications of basic principles of Physiology. The development of a horizontally integrated planner and its implementation within basic sciences departments received a lot of effort and work input from faculty and can be considered as a milestone in undergraduate academic teaching of medical sciences.

The faculty of the Physiology department has published research papers in both national and international impact factor journals. The faculty is also actively involved in attending national conferences and CME training programs.

Future plans of the department include the establishment of Post Graduate M.Phil Physiology program and production of quality research involving cutting-edge molecular and genetic techniques.





DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACOLOGY

The use of medicines is one of the principal ways of combating disease. The development of new and successful drugs requires advances and insights generated by scientific research. Pharmacology is concerned with the effects of drugs on living organisms whereas therapeutics deals specifically with the treatment of disease and the art and science of healing.

The Department of Pharmacology & Therapeutics is focused on basic life sciences research, undergraduate teaching for medical and dental students. The department is also involved in postgraduate teaching of biomedical sciences students.

The Department has completed many research projects in collaboration with different scientists around the world. Many research projects are in phase of their completion. The main aim of our work is to understand mechanistically the critical building blocks of biological systems from molecules to cells and organ systems, in health and disease, and to identify components that can be modified through pharmacology or other therapeutic strategies to cure disease. The faculty also enjoys international recognition for its contributions to research and service on grant review committees and editorial boards. During the period of COVID-19 Pandemic the Department is actively involved in online teaching, assessments, training workshops and faculty development programs. The department aspires to do clinical trials in future with full zeal.



DEPARTMENT OF PATHOLOGY

The subject of Pathology is bridge between basic and clinical subjects. It takes students from Morbid Anatomy to Surgical Pathology, Histology to Histopathology, normal body functioning and biochemistry to etiology and pathogenesis of diseases. The Pathology department is located at 2nd Floor of Indus Medical College.

The main Pathology department comprises of student's teaching Labs, multimedia installed tutorial, conferences rooms and modern Pathology lecture theatres. The Microbiology and Histopathology Labs are functional in Pathology Department. The Haematological, Clinical, Chemical, Immunological, Blood Bank and specialized tests services are available at Indus Medical College Hospital Lab under the supervision of consultants in each field.





DEPARTMENT OF FORENSIC MEDICINE

Forensic Medicine is a state medicine which deals with the application of principles of medical to the purpose of law and to furthering of justice. Forensic medical examination is a highly responsible and difficult task requiring trained staff and purpose built and well-equipped examination centers for examination of the living and dead. The subject spreads into almost every branch of medicine. It covers the responsibilities of doctors towards the State, patients and towards each other. The department consists of faculty offices, a purpose-built lecture hall with all modern facilities including multimedia, forensic museum and forensic laboratory.

The objective of Forensic Medicine plan of study is to produce a doctor who should :

Know the rights & duties of a doctor when he / she comes in contact with the courts.

Know the principles of Forensic Medicine including the recognition, collection, identification, preservation & documentation of physical evidence within the criminal justice system.

Be able to document & orally describe crime scenes, physical evidence & scientific processes. Be able to perform medicolegal autopsies & medicolegal examination of living victims of physical & sexual assault.

Has an understanding of certain provisions of law falling under Pakistan Penal Code (PPC) & Criminal procedure Code.



DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY MEDICINE

Community Medicine is the branch of science which deals with health of the community. Health needs of the population are measured and appropriate strategies are developed to improve the health status of the community through health promotion, disease prevention and health protection. Community medicine is taught in the 4th year of the MBBS program. The main goal of our department is to inculcate the qualities of a “seven star doctors” in our undergraduate students.

Core Components of the course are Epidemiology, Biostatistics, Health Care System, Health Education, Health Planning, Maternal & Child Health, Family Planning, Communicable and Non-Communicable Diseases' Prevention & Control Strategies. Field visits are mandatory for the students, which will help them to be more aware of grass root problems of their community.

Research is also one of the core components of our curriculum. During their Research Projects students learn questionnaire designing, data collection, data analysis and academic writing skills which help them to widen their knowledge base.



DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAL EDUCATION

(HEALTH PROFESSIONS EDUCATION-HPE)

In the contemporary era Medical Education the department of Health Professions Education (HPE) is an indispensable discipline to train medical teachers in various fields including curriculum designing, follow newer methods of teaching / learning as well as assessment. Like any other medical institution of high standard the Indus Medical College (IMC) responded to the standards set by the Pakistan Medical and Dental Council (PM&DC) and Pakistan Medical Commission (PMC) to set well set department of HPE at the institution.

The Department is headed by Prof. Dr. Inayatullah Memon who qualified MCPS-SHPE from CPSP and Joint Masters in HPE from Maastricht's University and Suez Canal University. Besides two faculty members both qualified in HPE are Dr. Umair Ali Soomro and Dr. Shumail Saeed Siddiqui.

OUR MISSION IS:

1. To formulate and implement undergraduate and postgraduate curriculum commensurate with PM&DC / PMC as guided by global organization (World Federation of Medical Education (WFME) and regional (Easter Mediterranean Regional Organization (EMRO).
2. Adopt standards set by these organizations in all the fields HPE including curriculum designing, teaching / learning and assessment.
3. To continue and add innovative methods of Faculty Development including workshops, lectures etc.
4. Add recommended teaching / learning strategies in our curriculum such as Student Centered Learning, Peer Assisted Learning (PAL), Small Group Discussions (SGD) e.g. Problem Based Learning (PBL) etc.

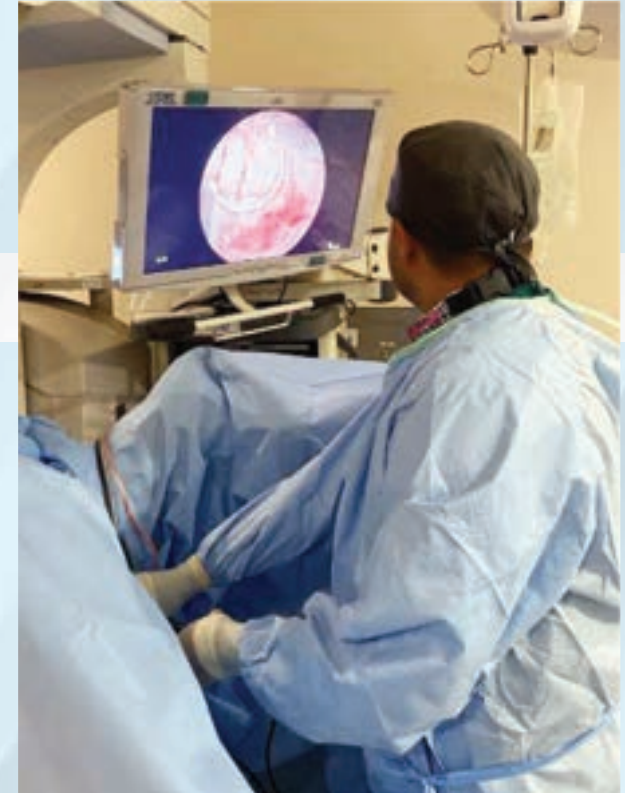


DEPARTMENT OF UROLOGY

The curriculum is organized and integrated along horizontal and vertical dimensions. Our students learn medical knowledge in a holistic integrated manner; thus allowing them to gain expertise in clinical skills alongside the acquisition of medical knowledge.

Lectures

Academic lectures though modified for active learning still form the corner stone of studies are held in the state of the art lecture theaters. Not only are the lecture theaters spacious and air conditioned but are well equipped with latest audiovisual aids like multimedia, overhead projectors and video presenters. Learning is facilitated by the seasoned faculty members who provide the students with a roadmap to knowledge tailored to learning objectives along with identifying practical relevance and the latest trends in the subject. Students learn through a variety of audiovisual aids and are encouraged to actively participate in reflecting and developing understanding of the topic through interaction. In order to enhance relevance and students' interest, learning strategies such as case-based learning and small group problem solving sessions are also effectively utilized.



Tutorials / Group Based Learning

Active student involvement as well as self regulation of learning is fundamental to develop lifelong learners. For this purpose, students are provided with a variety of platforms to enhance their learning and consolidate concepts. Presentations by students, interactive sessions and peer discussion are the modalities employed to promote students contribution to learning as well as encouraging students to interact and learn from their peers.





Hands On Training

Inert knowledge that is not utilized or put into practice has no role in the field of medicine. For this reason, practical and hands on training sessions are incorporated from the very early years in order to develop relevance and reinforce the concepts developed in teaching sessions. Laboratory work forms a critical part of training in the subjects of Physiology, Biochemistry, Histology, Pharmacology and Pathology. Experiential learning not only adds to students' interest but leads to greater retention of concepts to be applied in practical life. Dissection Hall in Anatomy is one such avenue that allows the students to learn the gross anatomical structures through direct observation thus endowing students with a sound basis of knowledge to be utilized in their practice of Surgery. The Power Lab in Physiology as well as Cyber Anatomy in the dissection hall are custom built, fulfilling the needs of contemporary medical training.

Clinical Teaching

Theoretical and practical knowledge is supplemented by clinical case presentations to provide students with clinical exposure in the pre-clinical and clinical classes.

Seminars

Indus Medical College regularly organizes seminars where groups of students present topics of general interest before a larger audience. This widens their scope of learning and supports their knowledge with research.

Self Directed Learning

A true learner is one who is endowed with the ability to direct, regulate, monitor and assess his own learning. Keeping with the spirit of developing lifelong learners, Indus Medical College endeavors to provide students with ample opportunities to tailor learning to their own individual needs and interests and to become responsible for their own learning. Students are encouraged to broaden their scope of reading and research in their areas of interest in order to develop sound knowledge and concept base



Community Oriented Learning

A doctor cannot be regarded as a true professional if he is not cognizant of the needs of the community and does not contribute to raising the health standard of the local community. Under the cap of Community Oriented Education Programs, students and the faculty of IMC actively serve the general community while at the same time this develops a sense of community ownership in the students.

Our students are active participants in carrying out community based research. Moreover they are encouraged to participate in the preventive and curative care of patients in Primary Health Care settings. The students take part in the campaign against Polio & participate in the surveillance being carried out regarding School Health Service. Every student of 3rd year MBBS conducts a House hold survey individually. Since inception students have been taking part in a vast campaign for creating awareness about emerging and prevalent health problems as well as their control.



OUTCOMES

Medical students are tomorrow's doctors. Graduates of Indus Medical College must make the care of patients their first concern, applying their knowledge and skills in a competent, ethical, and professional manner and taking responsibility for their own actions in complex and uncertain situations. Outcomes of IMC graduates have been adopted from WHO 'Five Star Doctor' and further two competencies were added on suggestion and recommendation of PMC for undergraduate curriculum. These competencies of 'Seven Star Doctor' have been endorsed by PMC in its curriculum, which says that a graduated physician should be a:

- Communicator
- Community Leader
- Manager
- Researcher
- Lifelong learner

We recognize and expect that our graduates will have achieved these competencies described in the "Outcomes for Indus Medical College Graduates" By the end of MBBS Program our graduate will be to:

- Provide cost effective, evidence-based care to their patients
- Take the most appropriate decisions for the patients
- Communicate effectively with patients and other members of health care team\ Demonstrate leadership and management skills that are required to ensure the provision of high-quality patient care
- Use managerial skills essential for administrative management of health care facilities
- Appraise and conduct scientific research to generate evidence in response to emerging health issues
- Demonstrate lifelong learning by using self-directed learning (SDL) skills.

OUTCOME 1: CARE PROVIDER (Knowledge, Skills, Attitudes)

Our graduate would be able to provide standard treatment to ailments. They must ensure that the treatment is of the highest quality. In addition to providing individual treatment, they should understand social, mental and physical needs of the patients based on psychosocial model of health. A doctor must serve all patients regardless of ethnic, racial, religious and economic ability of patients. The doctor must ensure that a full range of treatment will be dispensed in ways that are complementary, integrated and continuous.

OUTCOME 2: DECISION MAKER (Skills, Attitude):

They will have to take decisions that can be justified in terms of efficacy and cost. They have to choose the most appropriate and the best decisions for their patient. And they have to know the negative and the positive impact for the decision they have been taken. The decisions taken must be the best decisions according to the existing condition.



OUTCOMES

OUTCOME 3: COMMUNICATOR (Attitude):

Our graduate would be a good communicator in order to persuade individuals, families and the communities to adopt healthy lifestyles. Communications skills are essential for medical practice. It is a backbone over which lot of areas of patient care rests such as, first contact patient interviews, probing for associated and additional problems, counseling the patient, explaining treatment options, its complications and advising follow-up. It is also necessary for explaining risks to the patient, counseling in case of bereavement or mishap, providing information about a surgical procedure its complications, taking an informed consent.

OUTCOME 4: COMMUNITY LEADER (Knowledge, Skills, Attitude):

Our graduate would be a good community leader. Leadership and management skills are required to ensure the provision of high-quality patient care. Clinical quality depends on inter- professional teamwork, and therefore, leadership and management skills are needed at all levels. Our medical graduates are expected to have skills to deal with and resolve conflicts, learn to share leadership, prepare others to help and replace them, take mutual responsibility and discuss their performance.

OUTCOME 5: MANAGER (Skills, Attitude):

Our graduate would have managerial skills. This skill is very essential for a doctor, because they have to manage, for example, the administrative management of patients, the redemption of prescriptions, etc. Those things are often considered trivial, but if not handled properly, it will complicate the job. This skill would enable them to initiate exchanges of information in order to make better decisions, and to work within a multidisciplinary team in close association with other partners for health and social development.

OUTCOME 6: RESEARCHER (Knowledge, Skills):

Our graduates would have essential research skills. Healthcare decision-making is largely reliant on evidence-based medicine and understanding and using scientific methods is an essential skill to acquire for our medical graduates. It is essential to inculcate critical thinking and reasoning skills and to develop a positive attitude among medical students towards scientific research from the beginning of their medical career. In this context, research projects during undergraduate studies, not only foster analytical thinking and self-directed learning skills among students, but also improves their oral and written communication skills. Furthermore, these projects play a role in producing physicians who are better equipped to evaluate and apply new knowledge to their profession.



OUTCOMES

OUTCOME 7: LIFE LONG LEARNER (Knowledge, Skills, Attitude):

Medical knowledge, skills, and social requirements for patient care are quickly changing, thus, medical doctors are anticipated to be life-long learners to provide effective care for the patients. Lifelong learning can be characterized as “continuously supportive process which invigorates and empowers medical students to obtain all the knowledge, attitudes and skills”. We inculcate this competency of lifelong learning in our graduates through self-directed learning (SDL) skill.



EXAMINATION CELL

- IMC has established an Examination Cell is responsible for :-
- Printing & photocopying of question papers at least 48 hrs before the examination, assuring high level of secrecy.
- Centralized checking and marking of MCQs by Optical Mark Reader (OMR). The OMR has the built-in ability to assess the different aspects of the MCQs.
- Banking of MCQs/ SEQs/ SAQs/ PBQs/ OSPE and OSCE questions with relevant keys prepared by designated faculty members.
- Forwarding questions before banking to the Medical Educationist for grading of levels/ analysis/ critique.
- Assuring conformity to standards and improving the quality of assessment tools.
- Safe record keeping of professional examination-related material of the college.
- Publishing the date sheet of module and pre-annual examination.
- Maintaining the record of the results of the module and pre-annual examination, submitted by the respective departments.
- Maintaining the updated record of the internal assessment (IA) of all the classes in separate folders, assuring its secrecy and accuracy.
- Forwarding the summary of IA to Examination Directorate for preparation of the result, at the end of academic year. Before forwarding the final IA is approved by the respective Head of the Department and duly countersigned by the Principal IMC.

OUR CURRICULUM

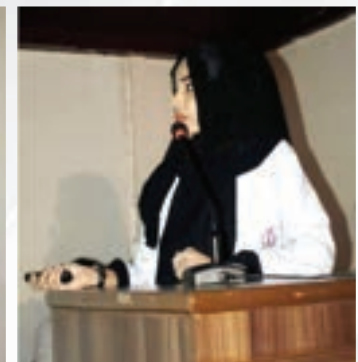

1. Must have passed the MDCAT Examination conducted by the National Medical Authority. As Per PMC Admission Policy.
2. Obtained a Higher Secondary School Certificate Qualification (“HSSC”) or an equivalent 12th grade qualification recognized in Pakistan and obtained more than sixty five percent marks therein, or a higher percentage as may be notified by the Medical and Dental Council.
3. Passed the subjects of biology and chemistry and either physics or mathematics in the examination of the Higher Secondary School Certificate or an equivalent 12th grade qualification recognized in Pakistan.
4. A-level applicants or from other than Fsc, need to have taken biology and chemistry as compulsory subjects and third subject can be either Physics or Mathematics. Aggregate marks should be at least 60% as per IBCC Equivalency Certificate. In order to obtain the IBCC Equivalency Certificate, please visit www.ibcc.edu.pk.
5. Register onto PMC Admission Portal for applying to Indus Medical College, Tando Muhammad Khan.
6. After registration SELECT “INDUS MEDICAL COLLEGE, TANDO MUHAMMAD KHAN, SINDH”, as your first choice.
7. The admission criteria is as under:
 - i. MDCAT 50%
 - ii. HSSC or Equivalent 12th grade Qualification Result 40%
 - iii. SSC or Matric 10%
8. Completing the admission process a Merit list after all the interviews are over, a MERIT LIST will be posted on the INDUS MEDICAL COLLEGE (IMC) website. This will be take place towards the end of December 2022 or in January 2023.

STUDENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- Indus Medical College stands committed to impart quality education to students and as part of its curriculum, to develop our students into well-disciplined and responsible professionals having respect for their character and fully accountable for their conduct.

- The achievement of this objective requires persistent devotion and dedication on the part of the students, with their focus on superior behavior and conduct.

- The information given below contains instructions and guidelines which will help the students to achieve the objectives of the "Student Code of Conduct."

- This information contains official policies of the IMC TMK, which the students are required to follow in letter and spirit at all times.

- The College will enforce and implement these policies formally and swift disciplinary action will be taken against any student flouting any of the rules/policies contained herein.

Attendance

- In the annual system of education, regular attendance in the classes is essential and monitored to ensure that the student has not missed any Lecture and Practical or fallen behind in her academic work.

- As per the College policy, student having less than 85% attendance is not eligible to sit in the Annual Examinations.

- Attendance of students is monitored through an online system of roll call in each class by the concerned faculty member.

- A latecomer may sit in the class even after the instructor has already marked him/her absent.

- Attendance after late arrival does not give the student any right to ask the instructor to mark him/her present. Instructor to mark him/her present.

Punctuality

- Students are required to be seated in the specified classroom before the commencement of the class. Students are expected to be quiet and well-behaved.

Dress Code

- Students are prohibited from wearing a dress that is provocative or indecent, has any inappropriate script/image, or is not according to local cultural values.

Creating Disturbance or Making a Noise

- a. Students will not scream or shout or make unnecessary noise in the corridors or the academic block.

Procedure for Meeting Management & Paying Respect & Wishing

- a. Students will pay proper respect and wish Assalam-o-Alaikum to all members of the Management and the Faculty.
- b. All employees of the College will be given due respect and courtesy at all times.
- c. Students wishing to represent any point or requirement/request to the Management mustnot barge into any office of the Management.

Parking

The parking of any motor vehicle on the property of IMC is a privilege granted by the College. To maintain a safe and clear means for the movement and parking of vehicles, parking regulations shall be followed contained herein.

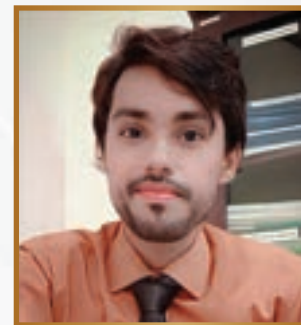
